1. Setting Up the Phone

- Assemble the Phone: Attach the stand to the back of the phone. Connect the handset to the handset port using the provided cord. If using a headset, connect it to the headset port.
- Power and Network Connection:
 - Power: Connect the power adapter to the DC5V port if not using Power over Ethernet (PoE).
 - **Network:** Connect the LAN port to your network using an Ethernet cable. If connecting a PC, use the PC port on the phone.

2. Configuring the Phone

- Obtain IP Address: Press the "OK" button on the phone to display its IP address.
- Access Web Interface:
 - Enter the IP address into a web browser on a computer connected to the same network.
 - · Log in using the default credentials (typically "admin" for both username and password).
- Account Setup: Navigate to the "Account" tab to configure SIP account details provided by your service provider.

3. Basic Call Features

- Placing a Call:
 - · Handset: Pick up the handset, dial the number, and press "Send."
 - Speakerphone: Press the speakerphone button, dial the number, and press "Send."
 - · Headset: Press the headset button, dial the number, and press "Send."
- Answering a Call:
 - Handset: Lift the handset.

 - Handset: Place the handset back on the cradle.
 - Speakerphone/Headset: Press the corresponding button or the "End Call" soft key.

 - Blind Transfer: Press "Transfer," dial the number, and press "Transfer" again.
 - Attended Transfer: Press "Transfer," dial the number, wait for the recipient to answer, then press "Transfer."
- Voicemail: Press the "Message" button to access voicemail. Follow the prompts to listen to messages.

5. Customizing Settings

- Ringtones: Navigate to "Menu" > "Settings" > "Basic Settings" > "Sound" > "Ring Tones" to select a ringtone.
- **Display:** Adjust brightness and contrast via "Menu" > "Settings" > "Basic Settings" > "Display."
- Network Settings: Configure Wi-Fi and Bluetooth under "Menu" > "Settings" > "Basic Settings" > "Wi-Fi" or "Bluetooth."
