





The Yealink SIP-T54W is a prime business IP phone designed for professionals, offering advanced features and an adjustable 4.3-inch color LCD screen for optimal viewing angles. The EXP50 is a color-screen expansion module that enhances the phone's functionality by providing additional programmable keys and a larger display. Here's how to set up and use both devices:

1. Setting Up the SIP-T54W Phone

- Assemble the Phone: Attach the stand to the back of the phone. Connect the handset to the handset port using the provided cord. If using a headset, connect it to the headset port.
- Power and Network Connection:
 - **Power:** If not using Power over Ethernet (PoE), connect the power adapter to the DC5V port.
 - **Network:** Connect the LAN port to your network using an Ethernet cable. If connecting a PC, use the PC port on the phone.

2. Configuring the SIP-T54W

- Obtain IP Address: Press the "OK" button on the phone to display its IP address.
- Access Web Interface:
 - Enter the IP address into a web browser on a computer connected to the same network.
 - Log in using the default credentials (typically "admin" for both username and password).
- Account Setup: Navigate to the "Account" tab to configure SIP account details provided by your service provider.

3. Basic Operations

- Placing a Call:
 - · Handset: Pick up the handset, dial the number, and press "Send."
 - Speakerphone: Press the speakerphone button, dial the number, and press "Send."
 - · Headset: Press the headset button, dial the number, and press "Send."
- Answering a Call:
 - Handset: Lift the handset.
 - Speakerphone: Press the speakerphone button.
 - Headset: Press the headset button.
- Ending a Call:
 - Handset: Place the handset back on the cradle.
 - Speakerphone/Headset: Press the corresponding button or the "End Call" soft key.

4. Setting Up the EXP50 Expansion Module

- Assembly:
 - Attach the stand to the back of the EXP50.
 - $\circ\,$ Use the supplied connecting sheet and screw to connect the EXP50 to the SIP-T54W.
- Power and Connection:
 - Connect the USB cable from the EXP50 to the USB port on the SIP-T54W.
 - If connecting multiple expansion modules (up to three), ensure the power adapter (5V/2A) is connected to one of the modules.

5. Configuring the EXP50

Assigning Features to DSS Keys:

- Access the phone's web interface.
- Navigate to the "DSSKey" section.
- Assign desired functions (e.g., Speed Dial, BLF) to each ke on the EXP50.
- · Label each key appropriately for easy identification.

6. Using the EXP50

- **Navigating Pages:** The EXP50 supports up to 60 DSS keys across three pages, with 20 keys per page. Use the paging buttons to switch between pages.
- Monitoring and Interacting:
 - BLF Keys: Monitor the status of extensions (idle, ringing, busy) and press the key to call or transfer calls directly.
 - Speed Dial: Press the assigned key to quickly dial a contact.
